

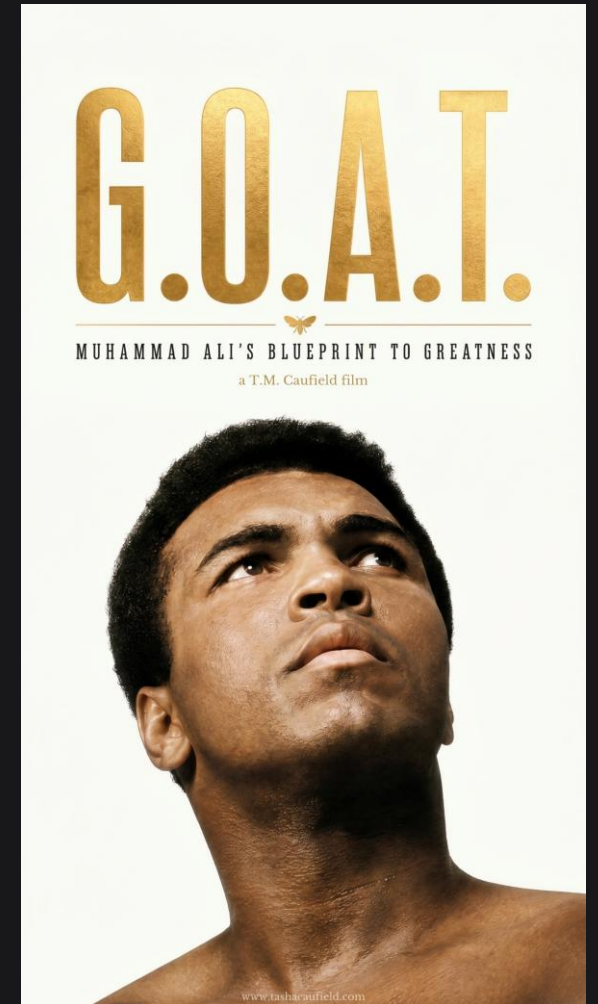

From an at-risk youth moving between the streets of Los Angeles and juvenile institutions, to the University of Southern California and a Warner Brothers Fellowship, T.M. Caufield (Tasha Caufield) has learned that overcoming adversity is possible — and that “success leaves clues.”

In researching what made Muhammad Ali “The Greatest,” she set out to uncover the blueprint he left behind — crafting a film that can serve as a path for those still oppressed, institutionally or mentally, to find the freedom they seek in realizing their own greatness. While advanced AI tools bring the visuals of her script to life, all research, scriptwriting, and historical analysis remain 100% human-led — separating fact from the fiction that has grown up around Ali's story over the years.

AI, Moral Courage, and “Athlete Activists”

AI Innovation vs. Historical Integrity in Documentaries

How does using AI to visually “resurrect” historical figures change how we experience documentary cinema? Explore the ethical boundaries of digital recreation, the line between visual enhancement and historical accuracy, and the future of AI in preserving history.

Faith, Conscientious Objection, and Moral Courage

What did Muhammad Ali's spiritual foundation cost him, and what can his principled stand teach us today? Examine his conversion to Islam, his refusal of the Vietnam War draft, and how faith sustained him through exile from the sport during his physical prime.

The Lineage of Black Athletes and Civil Rights

How did fighters like Jack Johnson, Joe Louis, and Muhammad Ali shape the intersection of sports, race, and social justice — and should athletes use their platform for political activism?

Legacy, Peace, and Historical Truth

Overcoming Adversity: The “Blueprint to Greatness”

How do personal trials form the foundation for lasting resilience and leadership? Connect Ali's life lessons with Director T.M. Caufield's own path from juvenile institutions to a USC film degree and Warner Bros. Fellowship.

5

Beyond the Boxing Ring: The Ambassador of Peace

How did Ali transition from a fiery young challenger to a global symbol of peace and quiet wisdom? Discuss his later, spiritual years and humanitarian work — and how public perception of iconic figures evolves over decades.

6

Debunking Myths vs. Historical Reality

Why is human research essential in an age of digital misinformation and media mythmaking? Examine how popular narratives around historical events get distorted over time, and why primary-source research remains critical.

Book Display

Pair the screening and discussion with a curated display of over a dozen biographical books on Muhammad Ali used in the research.

Poster Display & Meet the Filmmaker

Attendees can take a personal photograph with the filmmaker, creating a shareable moment and a memorable community draw for the event.
